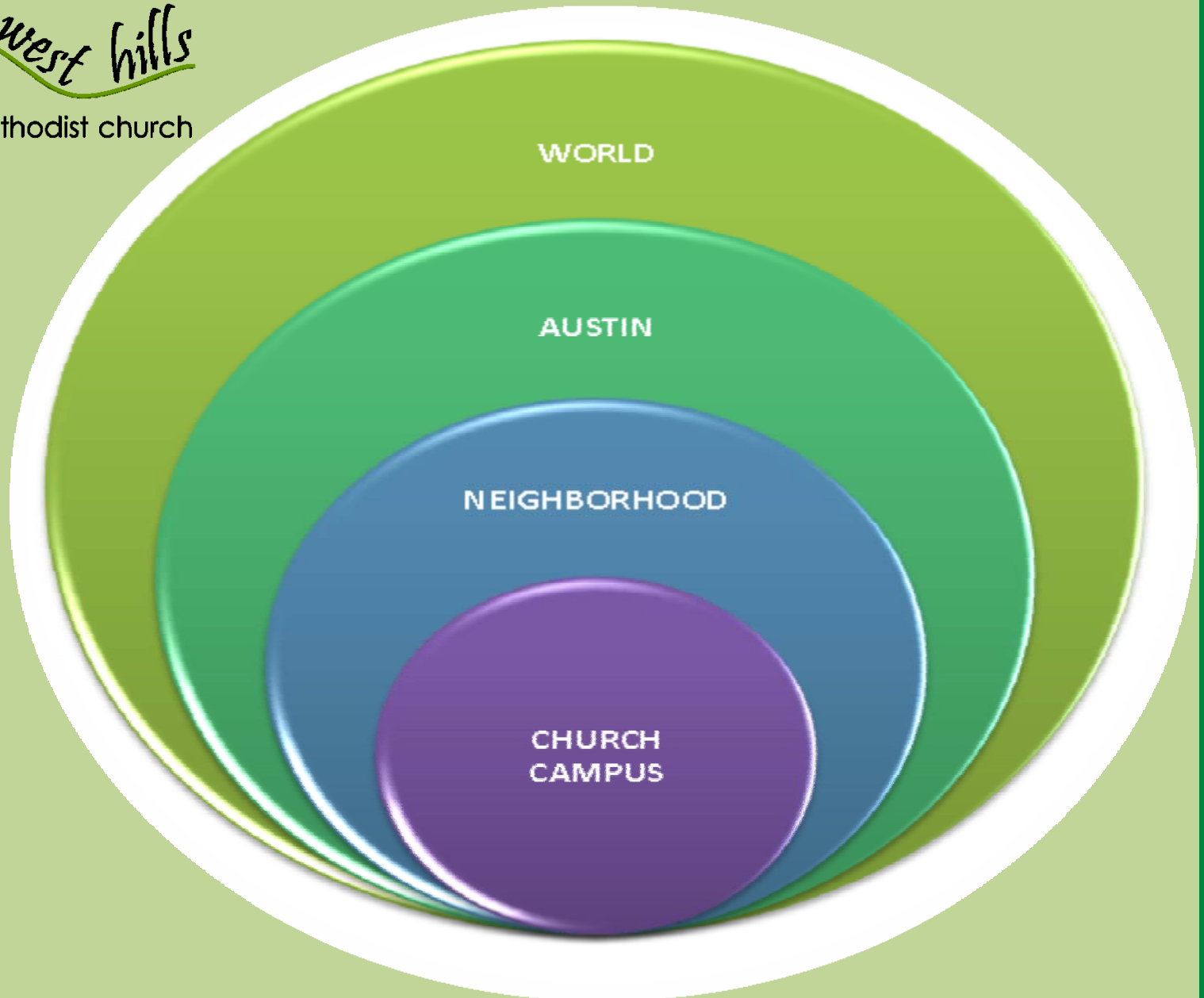

Prescription: The Pastor and Lay Leader in consultation with the coach will appoint a multi-generational team and launch a ministry audit.... The audit shall examine each ministry for how it aligns with the Mission and Vision of the church and produces results for the sake of the mission. Any ministry not aligned with the mission will be given 1 year to realign itself with the mission. Any aligned ministry ... not producing disciples will have an additional year to produce that fruit.

The ministry audit will be transparent and available for all to review and provide movement for the direction of the church.
