

Here are some facts regarding contributions made by the gallery in the last three years:

In 2016, the gallery distributed **\$750** to the After School Youth Program, the Prayer Shawl Ministry, and the choir.

In 2017, the gallery distributed **\$1750** to the After School Youth Program, the Prayer Shawl Ministry, the Pillow Case Ministry, and the Dance Team.

In 2017, the gallery has No far distributed **\$1300** to the After School Youth Program, the Clean Water Project, My Friend's House (kitchen renovation project), and to NWHUMC for general expenses. Money was also allocated for the future purchase of a Kathy Summers artwork from the upcoming May show, the Kathy Summers Memorial Show, and the Kathy Summers Scholarship Fund.
